Call to Order:

A meeting of the NorthLake Park Community School Advisory Council was held on December 11th, 2023. Janice Abrew-Coriano called the meeting to order at 8:06 a.m. Amanda Francis will record minutes for this meeting.

Approval of Previous Minutes:

Minutes were provided from the November 14, 2023 meeting. The November minutes were reviewed. A motion was made to approve the November SAC minutes, it was seconded and the minutes were approved. Attendance was taken and we established a quorum. A motion was made to excuse Jaclyn Miller, it was seconded and the absence was excused. Janice Abrew-Coriano asked for a motion to approve the agenda, a motion was made and the agenda for this meeting was approved.

Principal's Report (Announcements/HR & Budget Updates):

Our school earned an "A" from the state based on our test scores last year and will receive "A" money. Our school earned a 78 out of 100 to earn the A (last year we earned a 74). To receive an "A" you have to have at least a 62. The state has not told us how much money we will receive. SAC has until February 1st to approve how the money is spent. The school's Faculty Advisory Committee (FAC) will meet to create a ballot for the faculty and staff to use to vote on how the money will be spent. On January 9th SAC will meet to approve the FAC ballot. On January 16th SAC will meet again to review and approve the Faculty and Staff's proposed allocation of the "A" money.

We have been reviewing our latest FAST scores. 2nd grade scored great, however, we are reviewing what we can do to make sure the students are showing learning gains. The team is meeting to see how we can do more enrichment during our acceleration times.

Principal Archie is asking for a quote from Flocabulary for a ½ year.

We have hired 3 new staff members, 1 new custodian, Mrs. Ishu Martinez as a part time ESE and Brianna Piers as a full time substitute.
